1. OPEN PHOTOSHOP TEMPLATE

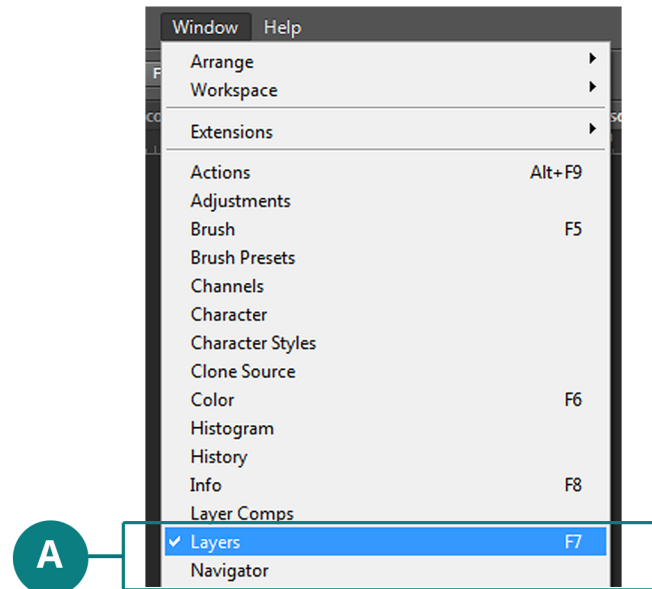
Take note of [safety margin](#), [bleed margin](#), [cut line](#), [binding margin](#), [dimensions](#), and [fold lines](#).

1A. For booklets:

- Open both the left and right pages.

For brochures:

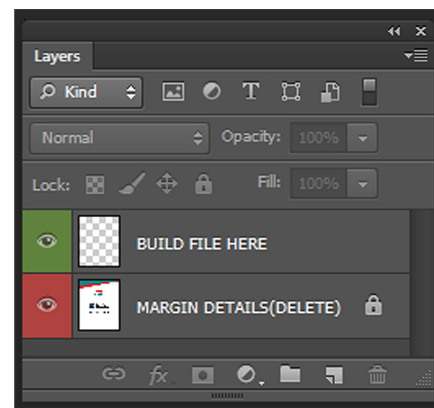
- Open both the front and back pages.



2. OPEN THE LAYERS PALLETE

FROM TOP MENU BAR:

- Click: [Window > Layers](#) (observe all layers)



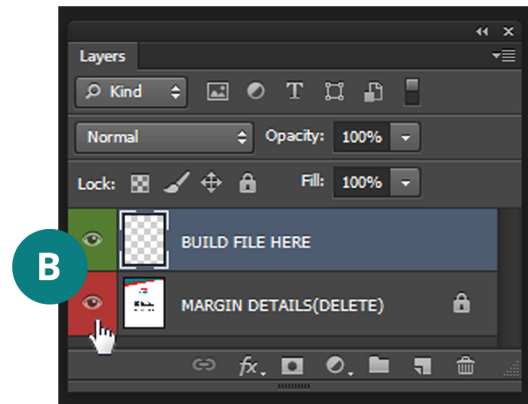
3. BUILD YOUR FILE

From Layers palette:

- Click: “BUILD FILE HERE”
* Make sure this layer is highlighted before building your file.

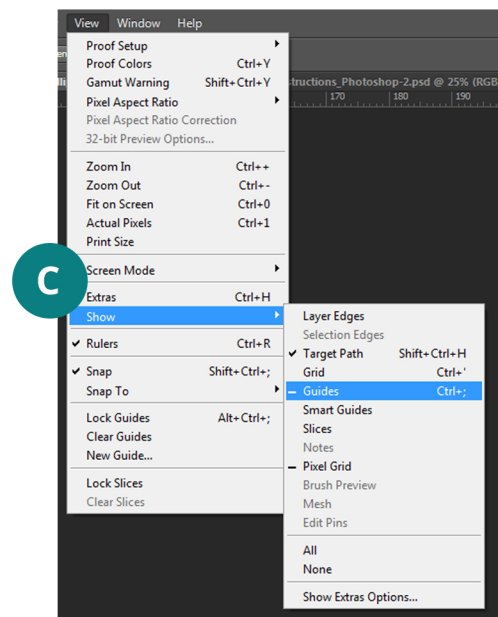
Tip: toggle the eye icon left of the “instructions” layer:

ON to view our instructions
OFF to view YOUR file



3A. To hide blue guides:
From top menu bar:

- Click: View > Show
- Uncheck: Guides



3B. To delete guides entirely:

- Click: View > Clear

3C. Image Color Mode

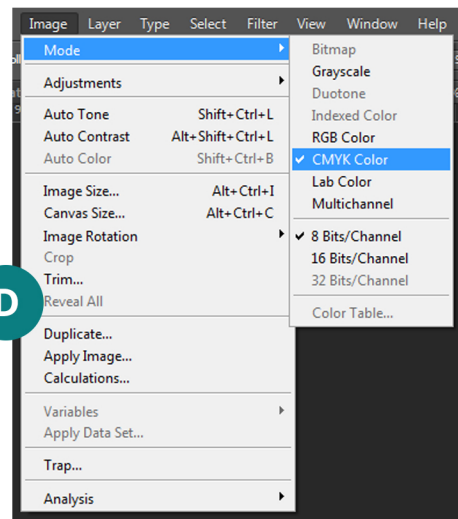
All images placed in your file **MUST** be in **CMYK**, NOT in RGB.

From top menu bar:

- Click: **Image > Mode**
- Check: **CMYK**

For best image print quality, make sure your images are at least 300 ppi



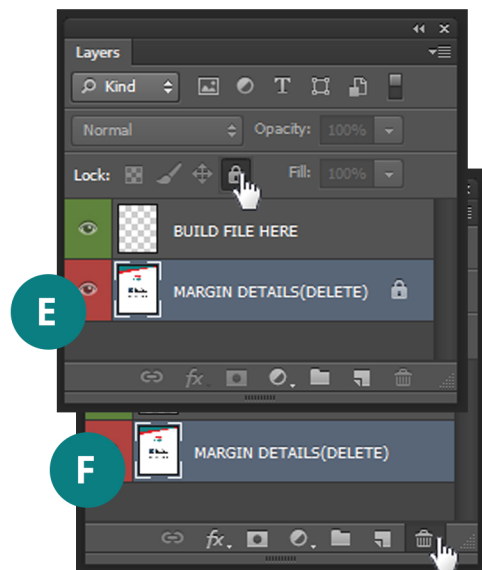
4. DELETE INSTRUCTIONS LAYER

BEFORE SAVING: Go to Layers palette:

- Click: "**MARGIN DETAILS(DELETE)**" layer
- Unlock the layer by clicking the lock icon
- Delete the layer by clicking the trash icon

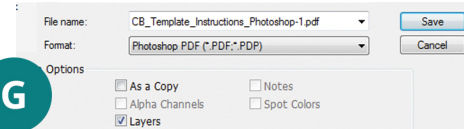

5. SAVE YOUR FILE

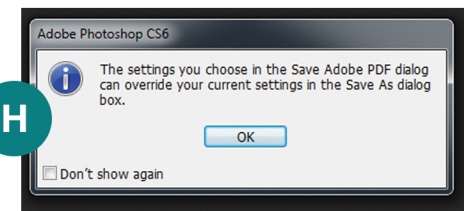
From top menu bar:

- Click: **File > Save As**
- Rename file and save as **Photoshop PDF**
- Click: **File > Save**



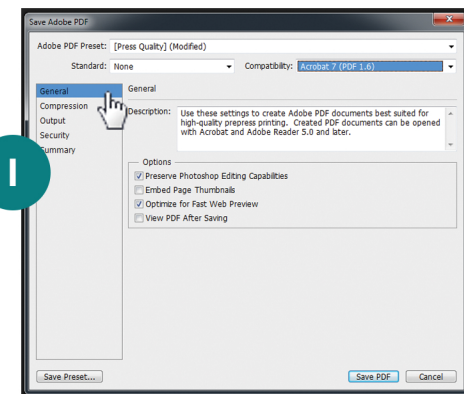
5A. If this pop-up warning comes up:

- Click: **OK** and proceed



5B. From Adobe PDF Preset drop down menu:

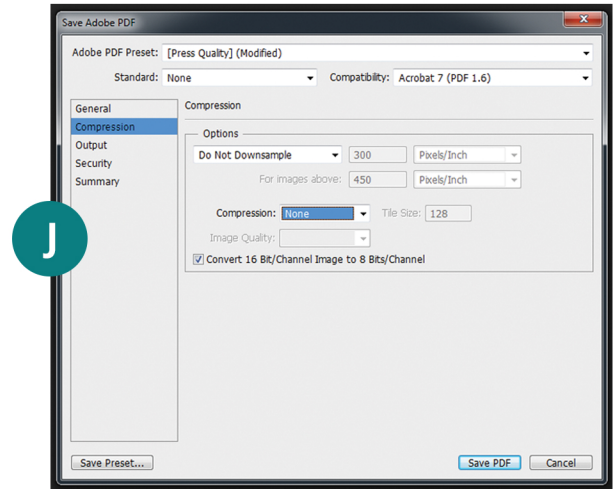
- Select: **[Press Quality]**
- Select: **Acrobat 7** next to "Compatibility"
- Uncheck: "Optimize for fast web Preview"



5C. Under “Compression” tab on the left:

- Select: “Do Not Downsample” from Options drop down menu
- Select: “None” from Compression drop down menu

5D. Under “Security” tab on the left:

- Please DO NOT lock the file with password
